Match Arrangements

For the **Girls Youth All-Ireland Finals**, both the Semi-Finals and Final will be played in the same venue, on the same date. The regional location is set out within the competition draw.

For the **Boys Youth All-Ireland Finals**, the Semi-Finals will be played on the same day, in the same regional location, starting at the same time (2 grounds will be used). The Final of each Boy's competition will take place in the afternoon following the Semi-Finals. The Final will be played in the venue of Semi-Final 1.

Duration of Matches

Semi-Finals will begin at 11.30am with the toss taking place at 11am.

Finals will have a start time of 4.30pm with the toss taking place at 4pm. Where possible the start time of the final can be brought forward.

Replay Dates

As per the competition regulations and playing conditions there are no replay dates for the Youth All-Ireland's. A result must be determined on the date outlined in the competition schedule. In the event that adverse weather conditions restrict a result from being determined on the field of play, a bowl out will take place to determine a result.

Umpires & Scorers

For both the Semi-Finals and Finals, participating teams must provide a scorer for the day who is familiar with operating NV Play. A Cricket Ireland scorer will be present at each fixture to support the club scorers.

Umpires for both the Semi-Final and Final will be arranged by Cricket Ireland in conjunction with the provincial unions. It is the duty of the umpires to be familiar with the competition regulations.

Team sheets

Team sheets are to be submitted to Cricket Ireland 5 days in advance of the Finals Day. Submission of a team sheet is required for preloading of the team sheet onto NV Play.

Clubs should list their 13-player squad, coach, scorer and manager names and send via email to **development@cricketireland.ie**, 5 days in advance of the final's day.

Support for Clubs

- For clubs hosting a Semi-Final & Final, CI will provide a €800.00 payment for the use of grounds and provision of catering.
- For Clubs hosting 1 Semi-Final, CI will provide a payment of €400.00 for the use of the grounds.
- Travel subsidies are not provided to clubs competing in the Youth All-Ireland Finals.

On the day

- As noted in playing regulations cricket Ireland will provide match balls for both the Semi-Final
 and Final of the Youth All-Ireland Finals. It is a requirement of each participating team to provide
 spare match balls in the event of balls being lost during the game.
- Lunch will be provided for all players and team management by the host clubs. Lunch will be provided following the conclusion of the Semi-Finals.
