



PART-TIME COMMERCIAL CREW ASSISTANT

BACKGROUND

Cricket Ireland is the governing body for the game at both performance and participation levels throughout all-Ireland, representing the interests of both the Men's and Women's game. Cricket Ireland was awarded ICC Full Membership in 2017 and is regularly involved in World Cup and Qualifying events. Cricket was also adopted into the Olympic Games for 2028.

The delivery of international cricket fixtures each summer requires the efficient, safe, and professional preparation of the host venues. The scale of event delivery has expanded significantly in recent years, creating the need for additional short-term support roles to assist the commercial team throughout the 2026 home season.

ROLE AND PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

The Commercial Crew Assistant will support the commercial delivery of Cricket Ireland's home international fixtures during the 2026 summer. The roles are essential to ensuring that match venues are prepared to the highest standard and that all commercial and presentation elements are installed, maintained, and removed safely and efficiently.

A key focus of the position is assisting with the build and breakdown of commercial inventory including perimeter signage, A-frames, stakes, branded structures, media backdrops, and associated event materials. Working under the direction of Cricket Ireland's commercial team, the successful candidates will contribute directly to the professional presentation of our venues and the fulfilment of key sponsor and broadcast requirements.

These positions require individuals who are hands-on, reliable, and comfortable working flexible hours, including early mornings, evenings, and weekends around match schedules, where required. Full training will be provided, and no prior event experience is required, though knowledge of cricket is beneficial.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Commercial Crew Assistant will support the setup and breakdown of commercial and operational infrastructure at Cricket Ireland match venues throughout the 2026 home season. Working closely with the Commercial and Events teams, the role ensures all signage, branding, and presentation elements are installed to a high standard, maintained throughout the event, and removed safely during de-rig.

EVENT BUILD

- Transportation and storage: transport of and installation of perimeter signage, including boards, stakes, and A frames.



Cricket Ireland

- Installation and Setup: Execute the mounting of pitch-side A-frames, tier banners, boundary wedges and press backdrops according to site plans.
- General support: Supporting general venue setup tasks as directed by the Venue Operations or Commercial teams.
- Safety Compliance: Adhere to strict health and safety protocols, particularly when working at heights or using access equipment like ladders and mobile platforms.
- Quality Control: Perform regular inspections to ensure all commercial branding meets sponsor specifications and aesthetic standards.

EVENT DISASSEMBLE

- Deconstruction and organisation: Safe removal, packing, and storage of all signage, commercial assets and underlying infrastructure.
- Transportation and storage: Ensuring all equipment is returned in good condition and stored correctly.
- General support: Assisting in returning the venue to its original state.

SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

- Strong work ethic with a willingness to work outdoors and perform manual tasks.
- Ability to lift, carry, and manoeuvre equipment safely.
- Reliable, punctual, and comfortable working flexible hours.
- A team player with good communication skills.
- Attention to detail, particularly around placement and presentation of commercial signage.
- Experience with hand/power tools and an understanding of materials like vinyl, metal, and PVC.
- Some roles require a full manual licence to transport materials between venues.
- Experience in event setup or similar roles is beneficial but not required — full training will be provided.
- Ability to travel, with own transport, nationally within the island of Ireland.
